Toronto - May 26, 2010 - "Sex, Drugs and the Holy Ghost" (SDHG) will make its world debut at the Toronto Fringe Festival, on Friday, July 2, 2010, presented and produced by **Under the Blood Productions**.

SDHG is a one-woman show that explores the unspoken truths of sex, drugs and God, through experiences of church members; an Ex-Sripper, Deacon's wife and 'tell it like it is' Grandma Word. It is produced, written and starring **Diane L. Johnstone**, co-produced by **Toni A. Thomas** and directed by **Winnie W. Wong**.
